On May 2, 2002, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and BellSouth Corporation (BellSouth) filed a petition requesting modification of a local access and transport area (LATA) boundary to provide two-way, flat-rated, non-optional expanded local calling service (ELCS) between various exchanges in Louisiana. ELCS is sought between the Albany exchange and Amite and Kentwood exchanges; and the Springfield exchange and Amite, Kentwood, and Independence exchanges.

Interested parties may file comments concerning this matter on or before **June 18, 2002** and reply comments on or before **June 25, 2002**.
