On May 8, 2002, Verizon Virginia, Inc. (Verizon) filed four petitions requesting modification of local access and transport area (LATA) boundaries to provide two-way, non-optional expanded local calling service (ELCS) between the Catocin and Alexandria/Arlington exchanges; Catocin and Falls Church/McLean exchanges; Catocin and Fairfax/Vienna exchanges; and Catocin and Herndon exchanges. All the exchanges are located in Virginia.
