ORDER

By the Chief, Consumer Protection and Competition Division, Cable Services Bureau:

1. On January 9, 2002, the Public Notice entitled, "Request For Exemption From Commission's Closed Captioning Rules," DA 02-29, was released. Pursuant to Section 79.1 of the Commission's rules, USA Broadcasting, Inc. ("USAB") sought an exemption from the closed captioning requirements for USAB's 13 full-power television stations. Univision recently acquired USAB and asserts that these full-power television stations are now part of a new Spanish-language network subject to different closed captioning requirements. Accordingly, Univision requests termination of the request for exemption filed by USAB.

2. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that Univision's request to withdraw the petition for exemption filed by USA Broadcasting, Inc. **IS GRANTED**.

3. This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated by Section 0.321 of the Commission's rules. 47 C.F.R. § 0.321.
