ORDER

By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. The Telecommunications Access Policy Division has under consideration a request filed by Middle Country Public Library, Centereach, New York (Middle Country).¹ Middle Country seeks an extension of a deadline for invoices filed in relation to Middle Country's request for discounts in Funding Year 2000 of the schools and libraries universal service mechanism.² Specifically, Middle Country requests that the deadline be extended for Funding Request Number (FRN) 394147 because of difficulties with its selected service provider.³ Upon our review of the record, however, we find that SLD approved Middle Country's request to extend the invoicing deadline for FRN 394147.⁴ Accordingly, we dismiss
