FORFEITURE ORDER

Adopted: December 10, 2002

Released: December 12, 2002

By the Chief, Enforcement Bureau:

1. In this *Forfeiture Order* (“*Order*”), we issue a monetary forfeiture in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to Manuel M. Vázquez for willful and repeated violation of Section 301 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (“*Act*”).¹ The noted violation involves operation of a radio station on the frequency of 103.3 MHz without Commission authorization.

2. On June 25, 2002, the District Director of the Commission’s Tampa, Florida Field Office (“*Tampa Office*”) issued a *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* (“*NAL*”) in the amount of \$10,000.² Manuel M. Vázquez has not filed a response to the *NAL*. Based on the information before us, we affirm the forfeiture.

3. **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT**, pursuant to Section 503(b) of the *Act*,³ and Sections 0.111, 0.311 and 1.80(f)(4) of the Commission’s Rules, (“*Rules*”)⁴ Manuel M. Vázquez **IS LIABLE FOR A MONETARY FORFEITURE** in the amount of \$10,000 for willfully and repeatedly violating Section 301 of the *Act*.

4. Payment of the forfeiture shall be made in the manner provided for in Section 1.80 of the *Rules*⁵ within 30 days of the release of this *Order*. If the forfeiture is not paid within the period specified, the case may be referred to the Department of Justice for collection pursuant to Section 504(a) of the *Act*.⁶ Payment shall be made by mailing a check or similar instrument, payable to the order of the “Federal Communications Commission,” to the Federal Communications Commission, P.O. Box 73482, Chicago, Illinois 60673-7482. The payment should note NAL/Acct. No. 200232700015, and FRN 0007-
