WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS NARROWBAND PCS LICENSES

AUCTION EVENT NO. 41

Report No. AUC-41 (Auction No. 41)

On March 27, 2003, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau announced that it was prepared to grant applications for the licenses listed in Attachment A to a winning bidder in the Narrowband Personal Communications Services ("PCS") auction (Auction No. 41), provided that the applicant made full and timely payment of the remaining balance of its winning bids.¹ The payment deadline was April 10, 2003.²

The Commission received full and timely payment, as required by section 1.2109(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.2109(a), for the applications listed in Attachment A. Accordingly, by this Public Notice, we announce the grant of the Narrowband PCS licenses listed in Attachment A. We grant these licenses pursuant to Section 309(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(a), and section 0.331 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.331, because it will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
