By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. Yeshiva Rav Isacsohn (Yeshiva Rav), Los Angeles, California, seeks review of a January 21, 2003 decision by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator).¹ For a review of decisions by SLD issued on or after August 13, 2001, appeals to the Commission must be filed within 60 days of the issuance of the SLD decision date.² Here, Yeshiva Rav filed its appeal on March 26, 2003, after the 60-day period, in contravention of our rules. We therefore dismiss the appeal.
