**VERIZON'S WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW**

On January 23, 2003, Verizon filed a request for permission to withdraw an application for review filed by its predecessor, NYNEX, of the above-listed NYNEX Transmittal No. 206 proceeding. Based on its request to withdraw, Verizon's application for review is dismissed without prejudice.<sup>1</sup> The NYNEX Transmittal No. 206 proceeding listed above is terminated.

Verizon also filed on January 23, 2003 a request for permission to withdraw an application for review filed by its predecessor, Bell Atlantic, of the above-listed Teleport *et al.* Transmittal No. 1 proceeding. Based on its request to withdraw, Verizon's application for review is dismissed without prejudice.<sup>2</sup> As Verizon notes in its request for permission to withdraw, the Commission's subsequent decision permissively to detariff the telecommunications services of competitive local exchange carriers moots the issues in this proceeding. Therefore, the Teleport *et al.* Transmittal No. 1 proceeding is terminated.
