WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS UPPER AND LOWER PAGING BANDS LICENSES

AUCTION EVENT NO. 40

Report No. AUC-40 (Auction No. 40)

On May 21, 2003, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau announced that it was prepared to grant the application for the licenses listed in Attachment A to the winning bidder of the Upper and Lower Paging Bands licenses (Auction 40), provided that the applicant made final payment before the deadlines established by the Commission.¹ The final payment deadline was June 4, 2003.²

Final payment was received for these licenses by the payment deadline. Accordingly, by this Public Notice we announce the grant of the Upper and Lower Paging Bands Licenses listed in Attachment A. We grant these licenses pursuant to Section 309(a) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. §309(a), and Section 0.331 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §0.331, because it will service the public interest, convenience and necessity.
