FORFEITURE ORDER

Adopted: January 29, 2003

Released: January 31, 2003

By the Chief, Enforcement Bureau:

1. In this *Forfeiture Order* (“*Order*”), we issue a monetary forfeiture in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) to J.L. Brewer Broadcasting of Cleveland, LLC (“Brewer”), owner of the antenna structure located at 35° 28' 12" North Longitude by 85° 02' 15" West Longitude in Dayton, Tennessee for willful violation of Section 17.4(a) of the Commission’s Rules (“Rules”).¹ The noted violation involves Brewer’s failure to register its antenna structure.

2. On September 9, 2002, the District Director of the Commission’s Atlanta, Georgia Field Office (“Atlanta Office”) issued a *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* (“NAL”) in the amount of \$3,000 to Brewer.² Brewer has not filed a response to the NAL. Based on the information before us, we affirm the forfeiture.

3. **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED THAT**, pursuant to Section 503(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (“Act”),³ and Sections 0.111, 0.311 and 1.80(f)(4) of the Rules,⁴J.L. Brewer Broadcasting of Cleveland, LLC **IS LIABLE FOR A MONETARY FORFEITURE** in the amount of \$3,000 for willfully violating Section 17.4(a) of the Rules.

4. Payment of the forfeiture shall be made in the manner provided for in Section 1.80 of the Rules within 30 days of the release of this *Order*. If the forfeiture is not paid within the period specified, the case may be referred to the Department of Justice for collection pursuant to Section 504(a) of the Act.⁵ Payment shall be made by mailing a check or similar instrument, payable to the order of the
