REGION 34 (OKLAHOMA) 700 MHz REGIONAL PLANNING COMMITTEE ANNOUNCES FIRST MEETING

The Region 34 (Oklahoma) 700 MHz Public Safety Regional Planning Committee announces that its initial meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 19, 2003, at Department of the Army's Oklahoma Regional Training Institute, 6500 N. Kelley Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

The meeting of the Region 34 (Oklahoma) 700 MHz National Public Safety Planning Advisory Committee will convene at 10:00 a.m. in the Education Center Auditorium. The agenda for this meeting includes:

- Elect a Chairperson for the 700 MHz Committee,
- Establish a 700 MHz Regional Planning Committee (RPC),
- Create an RPC meeting schedule,
- Review the PRC Committee process,
- Review the 700 MHz band development to date, and
- Set the next meeting date and time.

The Region 34 (Oklahoma) 700 MHz Public Safety Planning Committee meeting is open to the public. All eligible public safety providers whose sole purpose or principal purpose is to protect the safety of life, health, or property in Region 34 would utilize these frequencies. It is essential that not only public safety, but all government, Native American Tribal, and non-governmental organizations eligible under Section 90.523 of the Commission's Rules be represented in order to ensure that each agency's future spectrum needs are considered in the allocation process. Administrators who are not oriented in the communications field should

delegate someone with this knowledge to attend, participate and represent your agency's needs.
