ORDER

By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. The Telecommunications Access Policy Division has under consideration a Request for Review filed by Welch Public Schools (Welch), Welch, Oklahoma.¹ Welch seeks review of a decision issued by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator), rejecting Welch's appeal on the grounds that it was untimely filed.² For the reasons set forth below, we affirm SLD's rejection and deny Welch's Request for Review.

2. SLD issued a Funding Commitment Decision Letter on September 9, 2002, approving Welch's request for discounted services under the schools and libraries universal service support mechanism.³ Specifically, SLD approved Welch's request for discounts for Funding Request Numbers (FRNs) 863804, 863912, 864713.⁴ On November 26, 2002, Welch filed an appeal of SLD's decision stating that SLD incorrectly listed the category of service for each of the FRNs at

issue in the instant Request for Review as Internet Access instead of telecommunications services on its Form 471.⁵ On December 9, 2002, SLD issued an Administrator's Decision on Appeal indicating that it would not consider Welch's appeal because it was received more than 60 days after the September 9, 2002 Funding Commitment Decision Letter was issued.⁶ Welch subsequently filed the instant Request for Review with the Commission.

3. For requests seeking review of decisions issued on or after August 13, 2001 under section 54.720(b) of the Commission's rules, any such appeal must be filed with the Commission or SLD within 60 days of the issuance of the decision that the party seeks to have reviewed.⁷ Documents are considered to be filed with the Commission or SLD only upon receipt.⁸ Because the Welch's Request for Administrator Review was not filed within the requisite 60-day period, we affirm the Administrator's Decision on Appeal and deny the instant Request for Review.

4. ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to authority delegated under sections 0.91, 0.291, and 54.722(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.91, 0.291, and 54.722(a), that the Request for Review filed by Welch Public Schools, Welch, Oklahoma, on December 26, 2002, IS DENIED.
