**REPORT AND ORDER  
(Proceeding Terminated)**

By the Chief, Video Division:

1. At the request of Eastern New Mexico University ("ENMU"), licensee of station KENW-TV, Portales, New Mexico, the Commission has before it the Notice of Proposed Rule Making, proposing the allotment and reservation of DTV channel \*31 for noncommercial use at Roswell, New Mexico. ENMU filed comments reaffirming its interest in applying for the new noncommercial channel at Roswell, if allotted. No other comments were received.

2. We believe the public interest would be served by allotting DTV channel \*31 since it will provide the community of Roswell with its first noncommercial television station. DTV channel \*31 can be allotted to Roswell, New Mexico, as proposed, in compliance with the principle community coverage requirement of Section 73.625(a) and the minimum geographic spacing requirements of Section 73.623(d) at coordinates 33-19-56 N. and 104-48-17 W. Since the community of Roswell is located within 275 kilometers of the U.S.-Mexican border, concurrence from the Mexican government has been received for this allotment.

3. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective August 2, 2004, the DTV Table of Allotments, Section 73.622(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED, with respect to the community listed below, to read as follows:
