WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU GRANTS LOWER 700 MHZ BAND LICENSES

AUCTION EVENT NO. 49

Report No. AUC-49 (Auction No. 49)

On January 15, 2004, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau announced that it was prepared to grant applications for certain winning bidders in the Lower 700 MHz Band Auction (Auction No. 49), provided that the applicants made full and timely payment of the remaining balance of their winning bids.¹ The payment deadline was January 30, 2003.

The Commission received full and timely payment, as required by Section 1.2109(a) of the Commission's rules, for the application listed in Attachment A. Accordingly, by this Public Notice, we announce the grant of the Lower 700 MHz Band applications listed in Attachment A. We grant these applications pursuant to Section 309(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(a), and Section 0.331 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.331, because it will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
