ORDER

By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. Beth Jacob High School (Beth Jacob), Brooklyn, New York, seeks review of an October 21, 2003 decision by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator).¹ For a review of decisions by SLD issued on or after August 13, 2001, appeals to the Commission must be filed within 60 days of the issuance of the SLD decision date.² Here, Beth Jacob filed its appeal on December 26, 2002, after the 60-day period, in contravention of our rules. We therefore dismiss the appeal.
