## NOTICE OF STREAMLINED DOMESTIC SECTION 214 APPLICATION GRANTED

### WC Docket No. 04-18

The application listed in this notice has been granted pursuant to the Commission's streamlined procedures for domestic section 214 transfer of control applications.<sup>1</sup> The Wireline Competition Bureau has determined that grant of this application serves the public interest.<sup>2</sup> Level 3 Communications, LLC and Qwest Communications International Inc. filed letters in this docket regarding the use of management agreements, but the parties did not express any opposition to the current transaction.<sup>3</sup> Therefore, the Bureau did not remove this application from streamlined processing. For purposes of computation of time for filing a petition for reconsideration or application for review, or for judicial review of the Commission's decision, the date of "public notice" shall be the release date of this notice.<sup>4</sup>
