By the Assistant Deputy Division Chief, Telecommunications Access Policy Division:

1. On November 21, 2003, Bentleyville Telephone Company (Bentleyville) filed the above-captioned petition for waiver of section 52.23(c) of the Commission rules. Specifically, Bentleyville seeks waiver of the November 24, 2003 implementation date requiring Bentleyville to support wireline-to-wireless number portability.¹ On January 8, 2004, Bentleyville submitted a request to withdraw the above-captioned petition.² We grant the request to withdraw and dismiss the petition.
