WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU ANNOUNCES THAT APPLICATIONS FOR SPECIALIZED MOBILE RADIO SERVICE 900 MHz ARE ACCEPTED FOR FILING

AUCTION EVENT NO. 55 *Pleading Cycle Established*

Report No. AUC-55 (Auction No. 55)

On February 25, 2004, the Federal Communications Commission completed the auction of 55 Specialized Mobile Radio ("SMR") service licenses in the 896-901 MHz and 935-940 MHz bands ("Auction No. 55").¹ The long-form applications (FCC Form 601) for the SMR licenses listed in Attachment A have been found, upon initial review, accepted for filing. The Commission may return or dismiss any application if it is found, upon further examination, to be defective or not in conformance with the Commission's rules. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.934 (a), (d).

Petitions to deny the applications listed in Attachment A must be filed no later than **April 15, 2004**, ten (10) days after the date of this Public Notice. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2108(b). Oppositions to a petition to deny must be filed no later than **April 22, 2004**, five (5) business days after the filing date for petitions to deny. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2108(c). Replies to oppositions must be filed no later than **April 29, 2004**, five (5) business days after the filing date for oppositions. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2108(c). All pleadings filed regarding the Specialized Mobile Radio Service long-form applications should refer to **Report No. AUC-55 (Auction No. 55)**, as well as to the specific FCC file number of the individual application.

Under the Commission's current procedures for the submission of filings and other documents, submissions in this matter may be filed electronically or by paper, according to the instructions below.²

- **If filed by hand delivery**, an original and four copies of each pleading shall be delivered to 236 Massachusetts Avenue, NE, Suite 110, Washington, DC 20002. The filing hours at this location are 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. All hand deliveries must be held together with rubber bands or fasteners. Any envelopes must be disposed of before entering the building. The applications listed in Attachment A are available to the public for electronic viewing in the Commission's Universal Licensing System ("ULS"). Instructions for obtaining and using ULS are contained in Attachments B and C to this Public Notice.

After the pleading cycle, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau will announce by further public notice applicants to which the Commission is granting licenses. All winning bidders were required to pay the balance of their total winning bids in a lump sum payment by March 30, 2004 (or April 13, 2004 along with the 5% late fee). See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2109(a).

Any amendments to FCC Form 601 applications must be filed electronically.
