NEW ULS ONLINE SERVICES FOR MDS AND ITFS DATA TO BE PRESENTED ON JANUARY 28, 2004

A Public Forum will be held to present the new ULS online capabilities for Multipoint Distribution Service (MDS) and Instructional Television Fixed Service (ITFS) application and license data. The public is encouraged to attend.

As part of a continuing effort to improve the license application process, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB) announces the upcoming conversion of Multipoint Distribution Service (MDS, including Multichannel Multipoint Distribution Service, MMDS) and Instructional Television Fixed Service (ITFS) data to the Universal Licensing System (ULS). WTB will hold a public forum about the new online capabilities on Wednesday, January 28, 2004, from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM. The demonstration will take place at the Washington, DC headquarters building, 445 Twelfth Street, S. W., in the first floor South Conference Room (Room 1-B516). WTB requests that interested parties pre-register for the event by January 27, 2004.

The WTB is in the process of updating ULS to accommodate electronic filing of simple purpose applications for ITFS and MDS, and of converting existing license and application data for access in ULS. The demonstration will include topics such as:

- **Searches**
- **Conversion of applications and licenses**
- **Availability of Electronic Filing**
