ORDER

By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. The Telecommunications Access Policy Division has under consideration a Request for Review filed by Wood-Ridge Board of Education, Wood-Ridge, New Jersey (Wood-Ridge).¹ Wood-Ridge requests review of a decision by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator).² SLD returned, without consideration, Wood-Ridge's Funding Year 2002 application for discounted services under the schools and libraries universal service support mechanism because it omitted certain information required under SLD's minimum processing standards.³ Specifically, Wood-Ridge did not provide the Funding Year in Block 1.⁴ Consistent with existing precedent, we conclude that Wood-Ridge's application was appropriately returned for failure to satisfy minimum processing standards.⁵ We therefore deny its Request for Review.
