By the Acting Chief, Network Services Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

On January 4, 2002, the Network Services Division of the Common Carrier Bureau released a Public Notice in NSD File No. W-P-D-552 (DA 02-18), inviting comments for the captioned discontinuance application. On January 8, 2002, counsel for IP Communications Corporation (IP or Applicant) filed a request to clarify the scope of the proposed discontinuance. This Errata corrects the text in the released Public Notice as follows:

1. Delete the following sentence from Paragraph 2: “The application indicates that IP seeks authority to discontinue providing Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) service to its customers in Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma, and Texas.”
2. Replace the deleted sentence with the following language: “Applicant indicates that it seeks authority to discontinue providing only DSL service to certain of its customers in Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma, and Texas. IP estimates that approximately fifteen percent (15%) of its central office locations and less than five percent (5%) of its DSL customers in these states will be affected.”
