## FCC COMMON CARRIER BUREAU ANNOUNCES FRONT OFFICE PERSONNEL APPOINTMENTS

### *Bergmann and Rosenworcel Named Legal Counsel to the Bureau Chief Libertelli Appointed Special Counsel to the Bureau Chief for Competition Policy*

Washington, D.C. – Today, Dorothy Attwood, bureau chief of the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) Common Carrier Bureau made the following personnel announcements.

**Scott Bergmann** has been named Legal Counsel to the Bureau Chief. In this position, Mr. Bergmann will advise the Bureau Chief on local competition, broadband deployment and numbering issues.

Since July 1996, Mr. Bergmann has worked as an attorney-advisor in the Industry Analysis Division of the Common Carrier Bureau. He has worked on a variety of local competition and universal service matters, including proceedings addressing the deployment of advanced telecommunications capability and reform of access charges of competitive local phone companies. He recently served as team leader in the Commission's review of SBC's applications to provide in-region, interLATA services in Missouri and Arkansas.

Mr. Bergmann received a B.A. in Public Policy Studies from Duke University and J.D. from the University of Southern California School of Law.

**Jessica Rosenworcel** has been named Legal Counsel to the Bureau Chief. In this position, Ms. Rosenworcel will advise the Bureau chief on universal service and broadband issues.

Since May 1999, Ms. Rosenworcel has been an Attorney Advisor in the Policy Division of the Common Carrier Bureau. She has worked on variety of issues involving local competition and advanced services, including implementation of the Commission's line sharing rules and development of rulemakings concerning the deployment of next generation network architectures. In addition, she was responsible for development of a proceeding to reevaluate the Commission's separate affiliate rules for incumbent independent local exchange carriers. She also served as team leader for the BellSouth Georgia and Louisiana section 271 applications.

Prior to joining the Commission, Ms. Rosenworcel was an associate with the law firm of Drinker Biddle & Reath. Ms. Rosenworcel received her J.D. from New York University School of Law in 1997. She graduated with a B.A. in Economics from Wesleyan University in 1993.

**Christopher Libertelli** has been named Special Counsel to the Bureau Chief for Competition Policy. In this position, Mr. Libertelli will coordinate and advance the various competition policy proceedings and serve as the point person for these issues in the Common Carrier Bureau.

Since July 2001, Mr. Libertelli served as Legal Counsel to the Bureau Chief. Prior to this position, Mr. Libertelli worked in the Policy Division of the Common Carrier Bureau. His primary responsibilities included evaluating the Commission's unbundled network elements rules and addressing the Commission's treatment of advanced services in both the rulemaking and Section 271 review process. Before joining the Commission in 1999, Mr. Libertelli served as an associate in the communications law firm of Dow, Lohnes & Albertson in Washington, D.C.

Mr. Libertelli received a B.A. in International Relations from Boston University in 1991. He graduated from the Boston University School of Law in 1995 where he was the Bowler Communications Law Fellow.
