FCC REVISES ITS ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF REGULATORY FEES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002

Washington DC – The FCC has revised its Schedule of Regulatory Fees in order to collect \$218,757,000, as required by Congress for Fiscal Year 2002. Section 9(a) of the Communications Act, as amended, authorizes the Commission to assess and collect annual regulatory fees to recover the costs of its enforcement, policy and rulemaking, international, and user information activities.

The Report and Order identifies the revised fee amounts for each fee category. This information will be published in the Federal Register and will be available on the FCC's website at: www.fcc.gov/fees/regfees/2002regfees.
