Modification

L/Q Licensee, Inc. has filed an application for modification of its authorization for its Above 1 GHz Mobile Satellite Service satellite system. In this application, L/Q Licensee seeks authority to modify its currently-authorized 48-satellite NGSO constellation to a 40-satellite NGSO constellation. The modified constellation will have 40 satellites, in eight orbital planes, each with five satellites and an inclination angle of 52 degrees. There will be an in-orbit spare located at a parking orbit of 920 kilometers until needed. There will be seven in-orbit spares, one in each of seven planes.

Special Temporary Authority

PanAmSat Licensee Corp. has filed a request for special temporary authority, for up to 180 days, commencing as soon as possible, to: (1) relocate SBS-4 from 77° W.L. to 125° W.L.; and (2) operate the tracking, telemetry, and command payload on SBS-4 during the relocation and when SBS-4 is on station at 125° W.L. PanAmSat will not operate the communications payload on SBS-4 during its relocation or when it is at 125° W.L. without separately requesting and obtaining authority to do so. Operation pursuant to the requested STA will be on a non-interference basis, and any claim to assignment of Ku-band frequencies on a regular basis at 125° W.L. by virtue of the requested STA is expressly
