NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: August 5, 2003

By the District Director, Boston Office, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules,¹ to Comcast Cable Communications, Inc.

2. On July 24, 2003, an agent of the Commission's Boston Office inspected your cable system located in Middletown, Connecticut and observed the following violation(s):

- a. 47 C.F.R. § 76.605(a)(12): The field strength of the radio frequency energy radiated by your cable system exceeded 20 microvolts per meter at a distance of at least 3 meters from the leak, as follows:

3. Pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, Comcast Cable Communications, Inc., must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of the licensee with personal knowledge of the matter. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁴
