The Order, FCC 03-207, released August 20, 2003, is hereby corrected as follows:

1. Paragraph 2.d. is corrected to read "FCC Form 703, Application for Consent to Transfer Control of Corporation Holding Station License."
2. Paragraph 2.e. is corrected to read "Special Temporary Authority (STA), Application for STA."
3. Paragraph 2.g. is corrected to read "Submit Correspondence, Form for Replying to Correspondence Sent by the OET ELS Branch Pertaining to a Pending Application."
4. Paragraph 2.h. is corrected to read "Amend/Complete Application, Form for Amending or Completing a Page on a Previously-Filed Experimental Radio Licensing Application."
5. Paragraph 2.i. is deleted.
6. Paragraph 3, line 2 – the Web hyperlink is corrected to read:

7. Paragraph 4, the first sentence is changed to read "Mandatory electronic filing of applications for Experimental Radio licensees will commence on January 1, 2004."
8. Paragraph 4, the fourth sentence is changed to read "Paper versions of these forms will not be accepted for filing after December 31, 2003, unless accompanied by an appropriate request for waiver of the electronic filing requirement."
9. Paragraph 4, footnote 7, line 1 is corrected by inserting "See Section 553(b)(3)(A) of the Administrative Procedure Act," at the beginning and by deleting "see" before "*JEM Broadcasting*".

11. Paragraph 6, the beginning of the last sentence is corrected to read "Because this amendment merely clarifies an existing procedure and makes no substantive changes to the Commission's rules,".
