NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: December 30, 2003

By the District Director, Detroit Office, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules,¹ to Gerald Parks, licensee of radio station WEKC.

2. On December 16, 2003, an agent of the Commission's Detroit Office inspected radio station WEKC located at Williamsburg, Kentucky, and observed the following violation(s):

- a. 47 C.F.R. § 11.52(d): "Broadcast stations ... must monitor two EAS sources. The monitoring assignments of each broadcast station ... are specified in the State EAS Plan and FCC Mapbook. They are also developed in accordance with FCC monitoring priorities..." At the time of inspection, WEKC was monitoring one EAS source.
- b. 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526(e)(5): "Contents of the file. The material required to be retained in the public inspection file is as follows:...*Ownership reports and related material*. A copy of the most recent, complete ownership report filed with the FCC for the station..." At the time of inspection, no ownership reports were in the public inspection file.
- c. 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526(e)(8): "Contents of the file. The material required to be retained in the public inspection file is as follows:...*The public and broadcasting*. At all times, a copy of the most recent version of the manual entitled "The Public and Broadcasting." At the time of inspection, there was no copy of "The Public and Broadcasting" in the public inspection file.
- d. 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526(e)(12): "Contents of the file. The material required to be retained in the public inspection file is as follows:...*Radio issues/program*

lists. For commercial AM and FM broadcast stations, every three months a list of programs that have provided the station's most significant treatment of community issues during the preceding three months..." At the time of inspection, no radio issues/program lists were maintained in the public inspection file.

3. Pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, Gerald Parks, must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of the licensee with personal knowledge of the matter. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

4. This Notice shall be sent to Gerald Parks, Radio Station WEKC, 2528 Highway 895, Williamsburg, KY 40769.

5. The Privacy Act of 1974³ requires that we advise you that the Commission will use all relevant material information before it, including any information disclosed in your reply, to determine what, if any, enforcement action is required to ensure compliance. Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁴
