EchoStar states that the transponders associated with channels 3 and 5 are not sustainable, but that EchoStar 4 is capable of providing service on other channels. The application also includes a request for waiver of 47 C.F.R. Section 25.148(c) which requires EchoStar 4 to provide service to Alaska and Hawaii from 157 W.L.
