**NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

**Released: March 17, 2004**

By the District Director, Philadelphia Office, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules,<sup>1</sup> to Ramano's School Bus Service, Inc. ("Ramano's"), the licensee of station WPZN846.

2. On March 5, 2004, an agent of the Commission's Philadelphia Office inspected station WPZN846 and found the following violation:

- a. 47 C.F.R. § 90.425(a): "Each station and system shall be identified by the transmission of the assigned call sign during each transmission or exchange of transmissions, or once each 15 minutes (30 minutes in the Public Safety Pool) during periods of continuous operation. The call sign shall be transmitted by voice in the English language or by International Morse Code in accordance with paragraph (b) of this section."

Ramano's failed to transmit the call sign WPZN846 on the 460.125 MHz repeater station which is located at the Colonial School District Administrative Building, 230 Flourtown Road, Plymouth Meeting, Pennsylvania.

3. Pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>2</sup> and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, Ramano's must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific actions taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective actions. The response must be complete

in itself and signed by a principal or officer of the licensee with personal knowledge of the matter. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

4. This Notice shall be sent to Ramano's School Bus Service, Inc., 1065 Belvoir Road, Plymouth Meeting, Pennsylvania 19462.

5. The Privacy Act of 1974<sup>3</sup> requires that we advise you that the Commission will use all relevant material information before it, including any information disclosed in your reply, to determine what, if any, enforcement action is required to ensure compliance. Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.<sup>4</sup>
