NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: April 30, 2004

By the Resident Agent, Portland Office, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules,¹ to New Northwest Broadcasters LLC.

2. On April 8, 2004, an agent of the Commission's Portland Office inspected the antenna structures, ASR#s 1047244 and 1047245, located at 1006 W Marine Drive, Astoria, Oregon, and observed the following violation:

- a. 47 C.F.R. § 17.4(g): "...the Antenna Structure Registration Number must be displayed in a conspicuous place so that it is readily visible near the base of the antenna structure." The agent observed during inspection that the tower owner had not displayed the numbers.

3. Pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, New Northwest Broadcasters LLC, must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain the violation, must contain a statement of the specific action taken to correct the violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action. The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of the licensee. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

4. This Notice shall be sent to New Northwest Broadcasters LLC, 15405 SE 37th Street, Suite 130, Bellevue, Washington 98006.
