NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: August 2, 2004

By the District Director, Kansas City Office, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules,¹ to Colins Broadcasting Company, licensee of television station KSNB-TV.

2. On May 12, 2004, an agent of the Commission's Kansas City Office inspected television station KSNB-TV, licensed to Superior, NE, and observed the following violation:

- a. 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526(b): "The public inspection file shall be maintained at the main studio of the station". At the time of inspection, the public file was not at the main studio.

3. Pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, Colins Broadcasting Company, must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of the licensee with personal knowledge of the matter. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:

4. This Notice shall be sent to Colins Broadcasting Company, 205 S. West Street, Suite A, Visalia, CA 93291.

Any false statement made knowingly and willfully in reply to this Notice is punishable by fine or imprisonment under Title 18 of the U.S. Code.⁴
