NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Released: October 7, 2004

By the Resident Agent, Buffalo Office, Enforcement Bureau:

1. This is a Notice of Violation ("Notice") issued pursuant to Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules,¹ to Roy H Park Broadcasting of Utica Rome Inc.

2. On August 8, 2004, an agent of the Commission's Buffalo Office inspected the antenna structure, ASR# 1007794, located in Lowville, NY, and observed the following violation(s):

- a. 47 C.F.R. § 17.4(g): "... the Antenna Structure Registration Number must be displayed in a conspicuous place so that it is readily visible near the base of the antenna structure." The antenna registration number was not posted.

3. Pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,² and Section 1.89 of the Commission's Rules, Roy H Park Broadcasting of Utica Rome Inc., must submit a written statement concerning this matter within 20 days of release of this Notice. The response must fully explain each violation, must contain a statement of the specific action(s) taken to correct each violation and preclude recurrence, and should include a time line for completion of pending corrective action(s). The response must be complete in itself and signed by a principal or officer of the licensee with personal knowledge of the matter. All replies and documentation sent in response to this Notice should be marked with the File No. and NOV No. specified above, and mailed to the following address:
